SCHEDULE

RING ONE: SHOW-JUMPING Start: 09:30 a.m.

Class One: 60cm (may be split assisted/on own if sufficient entries)

Class Two: 70cm (may be split ponies / horses if sufficient entries)

Class Three: 75 cm (may be split ponies / horses if sufficient entries)

Class Four: Puissance starting at 80cm (run as BS rules i.e. maximum of 5 rounds)

Class Five: 80cm (may be split ponies / horses if sufficient entries)

Class Six: 90cm (may be split ponies / horses if sufficient entries)

Class Seven: 1m – 1.05m

N.B. All heights are the approximate heights of fences in the first round.

Show-jumping classes will usually be run under Table A7 (one round with a separate jump-off); this may be changed if circumstances dictate.

Entry fee per combination per class: Members - £8 Non-members - £10

RING TWO: CLEAR ROUND SHOW-JUMPING

Starting at 09:15 and will run until no more entries.

Entry Fee: £3 per round or £5 for two rounds for the same combination paid at the same time.

Pay at the Ringside.

Please put the jumps at heights to suit you.

RING THREE WORKING HUNTER Start 11:00 a.m.

Class Eight: 70cm (may be split ponies/horses)

Class Nine: 85cm (may be split ponies/horses)

ENTRY FEE per combination per class: Members - £8 Non-members - £10

TSR(The Showing Register) Showing Finals – This show is a qualifier for the 2018 TSR Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals: Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. The rider does not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals

TSR Riders Finals – 1st & 2nd placed riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals – the two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward. Cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/>

TSR Medal Awards – TSR members can collect qualification cards & signatures and redeem for a TSR medal – see the TSR website for details. (see above for website address)

BSHA Grass Roots Championships – with a TSR qualification card you can also enter the BSHA Grass Roots Champs in September at Addington EC – you do not have to be a BSHA member to qualify or enter the final. See www.britishshowhorse.org

RING FOUR SHOWING Start: 10:00a.m.

Class Ten: Riding Club Horse / Pony – any age of rider. Combinations will be required to do an individual show and may be required to jump at least one small jump.

May be split horses/ ponies if sufficient entries.

Class Eleven: Mountain & Moorland – any age of rider. May be ridden, on lead rein or in-hand. Rider must be of a suitable weight for the pony.

Class Twelve: Veteran – ponies / horses 15 years and over. (not a TSR qualifier)

Entries may be split A) 15 – 20 years B) over 20 years if sufficient entries.

Please put age of pony / horse on entry form. May be in hand, on lead rein or ridden.

Class Thirteen: RoR Intro to Showing – (not a TSR qualifier)

open to all horses that have been in Racing training. No group canter.

Class Fourteen: Show Hunter / Pony – any age of rider. May be split horses/ ponies if sufficient entries.

Class Fifteen: Coloured – horses/ponies. May be ridden, on lead rein or in-hand.

(TBC) – classes B (Prelim) and C (Novice) are qualifiers for the SSADL (Senior Showing & Dressage Ltd) National Finals – any competitor with a pony/horse aged 15 years and over with a final test score of 50% and above will qualify for the SSADL Senior Dressage National Finals. Competitors do not need to be members of SSADL to enter. Once qualified they can return their completed Qualification Letter to register with the Senior Dressage Series. They will need to enclose a photocopy of their horse/pony's passport (to verify the animals' age) with the Qualification Letter. Please see their website for further details:

HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY FOR THIS EVENT

1. The Organiser has overall responsibility for Health and Safety.
2. The event is organised in accordance with health and safety legislation and all who have (to any extent) control of premises or site at the event are responsible for ensuring that:
 - a) everything reasonably practicable is done to ensure health and safety and welfare of those attending the event.
 - b) those attending the event conduct themselves so that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk

4. Horses can easily be frightened and can be dangerous. Members of the public are requested to keep clear from horse areas/lanes and to avoid behaviour which might alarm horses.
5. Dogs **MUST** be on a lead and under close control at **ALL** times.
6. All competitors must ensure that they have adequate/appropriate insurance for themselves, horses, property and third party.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Judge's decision is final
2. Legal Liability: neither the Organisers nor any persons acting on their behalf accept any liability for loss, damage, accident or illness to ponies/horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property.
3. The Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the schedule.
4. Any objections or protests must be handed into the Show Secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the incident with a £20 deposit (which will be forfeited if objection is not upheld)
5. **Hard hats to the standard acceptable to British Riding Clubs (see their website) must be worn and correctly fastened at all times whilst mounted.**
6. All ages as on the day of the show.
7. Show-jumping will be judged under BRC / BS Rules 2018.

Dressage will be run under BRC / BD 2018 rules
8. The Committee reserve the right to ask anybody to leave the show ground.
