The good news for Mercian competitions in 2019 was that the 80cm & 90cm jumping classes were re-instated, after successful lobbying by Margaret Boyd at the Mercian AGM in Jan 2019! However, the smaller heights of 60cm & 70cm remain to encourage less ambitious riders to have a go.

There were 8 Mercian events, including an end of season quiz. We participated in almost all the events except the quiz.

As a club we traditionally do well over the jumps, which was true again in 2019, but we also did well at our weaker discipline - dressage. In the Worcester RC Dressage & Style Jumping show in June, we had CEVRC members who did very well! Clubs like Malvern & Worcester excel in this discipline, and continue to do well in the Mercian results table.

So once again, let's practice our dressage and try to win more of the Mercian competitions! Junior 2019 Results
